



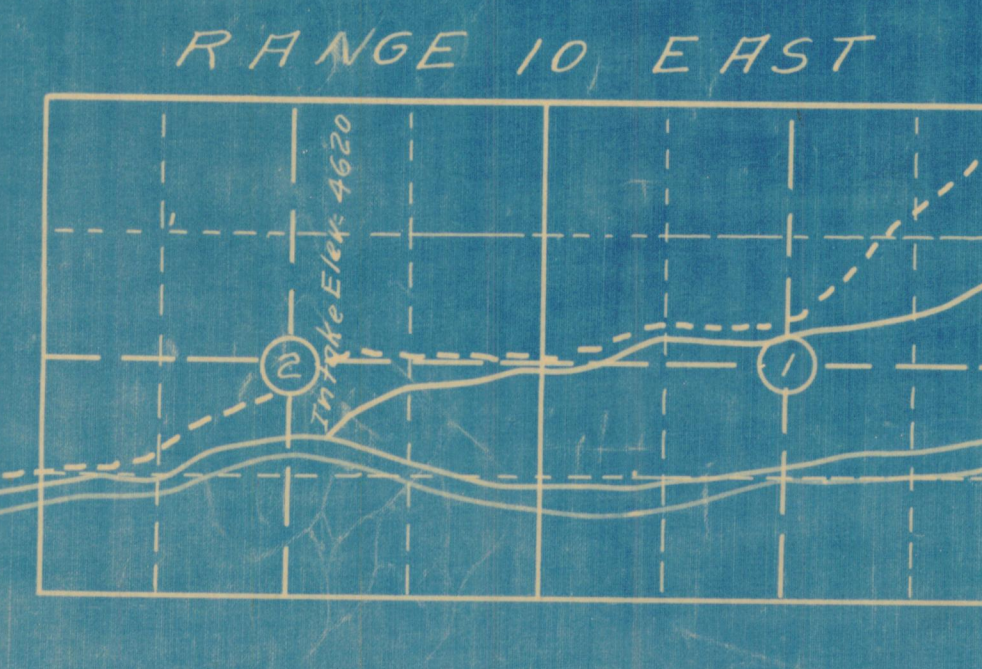

 I, *[Signature]*, being duly sworn, say that the engineer under whose supervision the survey and plan herein were made, that the tracks shown
 hereon to be selected are each and every one desert land, as contemplated by the Act of Congress approved August 15 1874 (23 Stat. 372-373), the act of June 11
 1876 (29 Stat. 413-414), and the act of March 3 1901 (31 Stat. 1133-1134), that he is well acquainted with the character of the land herein applied for, having person-
 ally examined same, that there is not to his knowledge within the limits thereof any vein or lode or quartz or other rock in place bearing gold, silver, copper, lead
 or copper, nor any deposit of coal, peat, cement, gravel, sand, or deposit of soil, nor any valuable mineral deposit, that no portion of said land is claimed
 for mining purposes under the local customs or rules of miners, or otherwise, that no portion of said land is worked for general farming any part of the year by
 any person or persons, that said land is essentially non-mineral land, and that the land is not occupied by any settler, that the plan of irrigation herewith submitted
 is accurate, and fully represented in accordance with the ascertained facts, and that the system proposed is sufficient to thoroughly irrigate and reclaim said
 land and prepare it for raising ordinary crops, and that the survey of said system of irrigation is accurately represented upon this map and the accompany-
 ing field notes.
